



A Memo to all boarders at Magic Moments Stable:

Common courtesy and a few Rules are necessary at the barn. These are the basic rules of the barn. Those found in violation will have to face the consequences. The Rules are as follows:

1.) All boarders must keep their belongings (other than Saddle, Bridle, and Saddle pad) in a tack trunk. The trunk is to be of moderate size and not to exceed 30 in. high by 26 in. wide by 37 in. long.

(All items found loose in the tack rooms will become common property, of magic moments, and NOT be returned.)

2.) Any horse who soils the wash rack or grooming area needs to be cleaned up after. (There are several manure buckets around.)

3.) All boarders or other individuals who schedule an appointment for a lesson or work session with Cody Siebert or any other approved trainer at magic moments will be held responsible for paying for the Lesson if the cancellation is not made 24 hours in advance.

(The cancellation may be made by calling granger on her cell phone (281-932-3643) or by contacting the trainer directly.)

4.) Hard hats must be worn while jumping.

5.) All persons riding at magic moments stable must have signed a magic moment liability release. (For boarders, it is included in your contract.)

6.) Visiting horses to magic moments stable property must have clearance from a magic moment owner before arrival. (Proof of vaccinations and neg. coggins within 12 months is required.)

7.) Any boarded horses at magic moments must have a signed release form from the owner and a magic moments owner in order to leave the property if the owner is not the one removing the horse. (Release forms

may be obtained from granger with 24 hours notice.) In the case of an emergency, please feel free to take your horse to the vet. Please leave a message on granger's voice mail (281-932-3643).

- 8.) Please keep the gates closed.
- 9.) All people at the barn must have shoes on at all times. Preferably shoes that have closed toes. If sandals must be worn, please wear the type that strap to your feet (i.e. Teva or Birkenstock type).
- 10.) Common courtesy is the best rule of all.
- 11.) If there are drinks available in the refrigerator you may drink them if you are going to replace them the same day. This is for the drinks that are not labeled as belonging to someone. They are there on the honor system. If you want to take one, please put one back.
- 12.) These rules are a foundation. There are not all inclusive. If there needs to be more rules, I am sure that I can come up with them, but I really don't want to have to. If you have any suggestions of rules that could be added to the list, please let Granger know.
